THE CALDER CONVOY 2020 - INDEMNITY FORM

16 and 17 May 2020

1. By signing this form the entrant acknowledges and agrees they will have no claim whatsoever against the Organiser's or any of the committee thereof or against any other person associated with the organisations of "The Calder Convoy" (of whom are hereafter ("The Organisers")).
 - a. Whether such claims shall arise out of personal injury or property damage.
 - b. Whether caused or contributed by act or omission of the organisers; and
 - c. Whether occurring prior to, or during, or after The Calder Convoy.
2. The entrant or participants also agrees that he/she will indemnify the Organisers against any claim as aforesaid which might be made by the drivers/passengers in the entrant/participants vehicle, against the Organisers.
3. I acknowledge that I have read, understood and accepted the rules and conditions of entry to The Calder Convoy.

To assist with the smooth running of the event, the following RULES and CONDITIONS have been set:

- a. All vehicles must be roadworthy, have current registration labels or permits affixed to the vehicles and drivers must be a holder of a current drivers licence applicable with the vehicles being driven.
- b. No vehicle will be permitted to run on trade plates.
- c. No substitution shall be made with the knowledges and written approval of Entries Director and the payment of such fees as the committee may set.
- d. All entrants/participants will observe the current road laws and speed limits on the route.
- e. All entrants and passengers will conduct themselves in an orderly manner. Entrants and passengers are subject to the direction and control in all things of the event Organisers, their agents and officials.
- f. Entrants and passengers conduct in a dangerous manner or in a dangerous manner likely to bring The Calder Convoy and its organisers into disrepute shall be disqualified immediately.
- g. The Organisers reserve the right to terminate any entry at any time for any reason.
